DAY 7: TRACY / ENDICOTT ARM FJORDS
True gems of southeast Alaska, these steeply walled fjords feature lush greenery and intricate icebergs.

DAY 8: SITKA
Snow-capped mountains, rich wildlife, and even a volcano highlight this historic outpost.

DAY 9: PETERSBURG
Seldom-visited Petersburg is nicknamed 'Little Norway,' and the villagers here proudly celebrate their Nordic roots.

DAY 10: WRANGELL
Numerous petroglyphs on the beach and moss-covered totem poles are reminders of the area's long history in one of the oldest island towns in Alaska.

DAY 11: MISTY FJORDS NATIONAL MONUMENT
Discover a realm of thick evergreen rainforests, granite cliffs adorned by waterfalls, rivers, and wetlands.

DAY 12: AT SEA
Sailing south, we journey through the Inside Passage, admiring places like Grenville Channel and Princess Royal Channel.

DAY 13: ALERT BAY, BRITISH COLUMBIA
Admire elaborate totem poles, paintings, carvings, and ceremonial masks in the local museum.

DAY 14: VANCOUVER, CANADA
